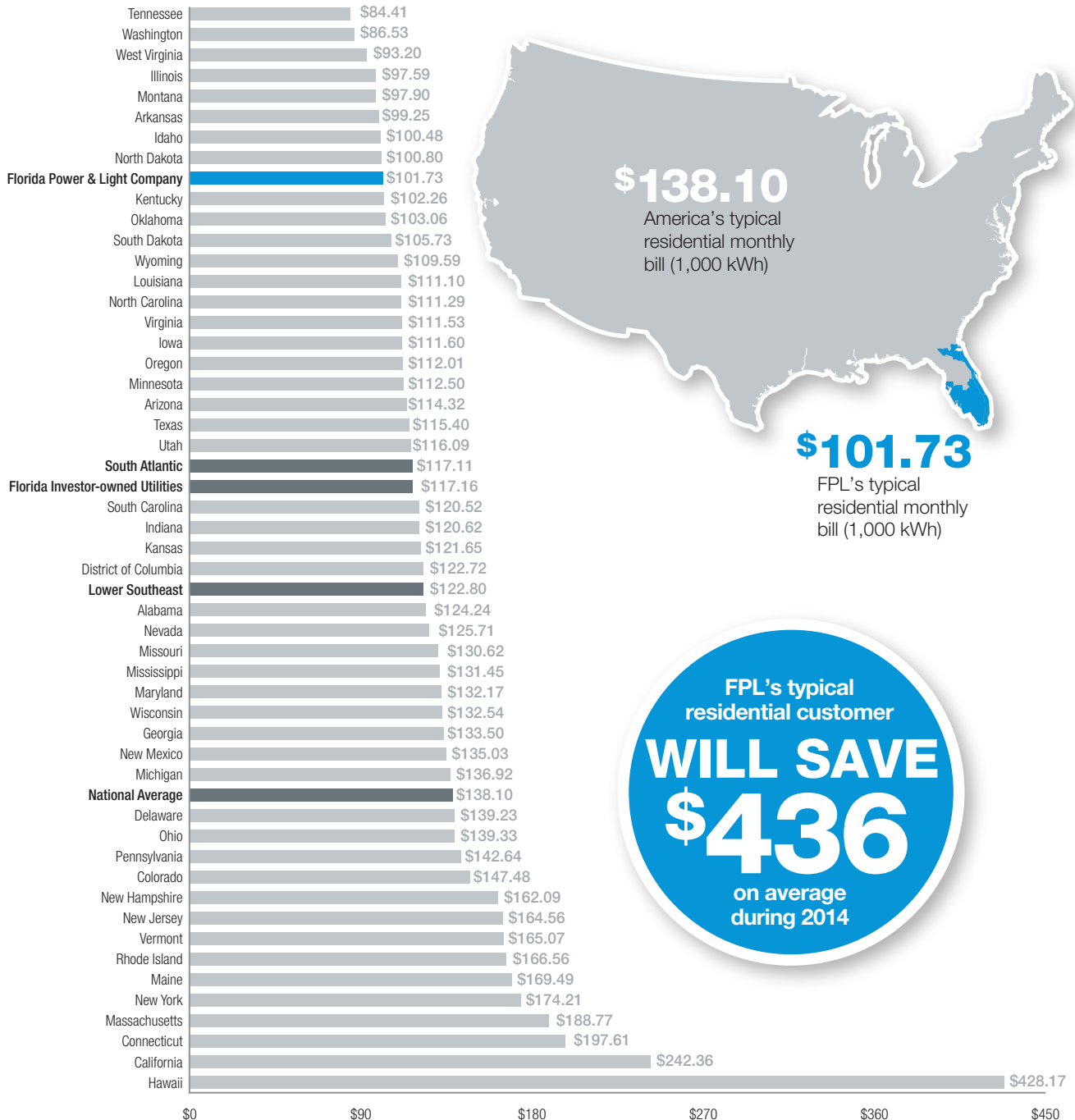




# Residential customer bills are about 30 percent below the national average
